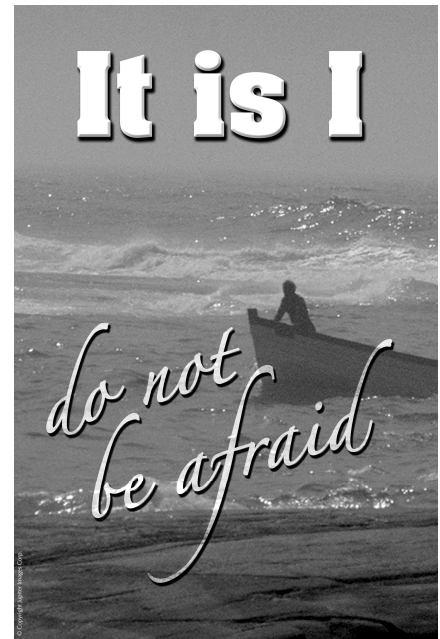

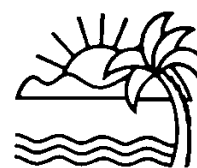
1ST ANNUAL BEACH DAY
