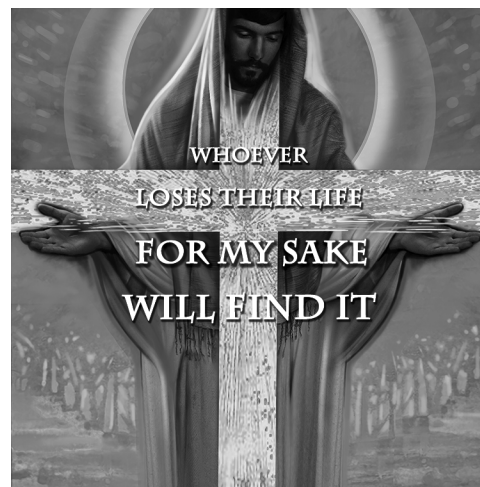

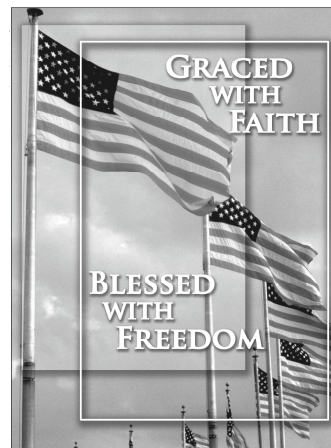

Cross crib is a more challenging way to play cribbage. Feel free to bring a snack or dessert to share.

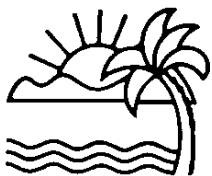
