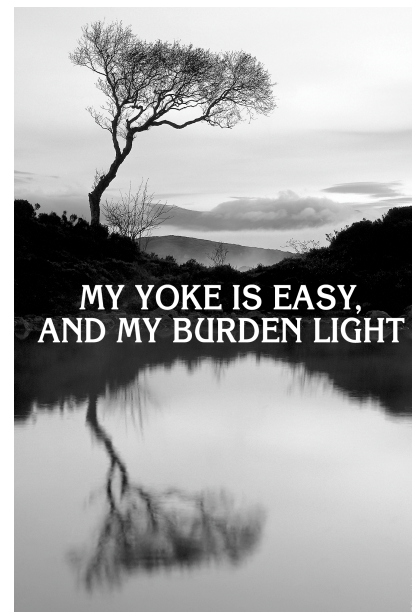

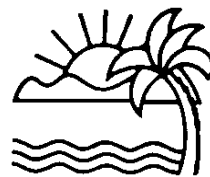


## *Prayer Shawl Ministry*
