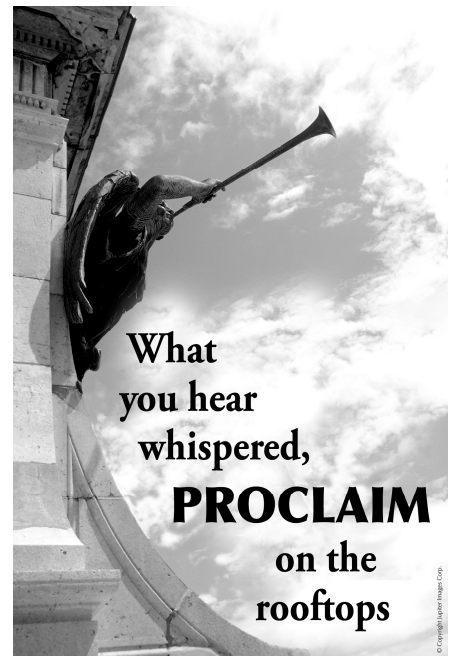

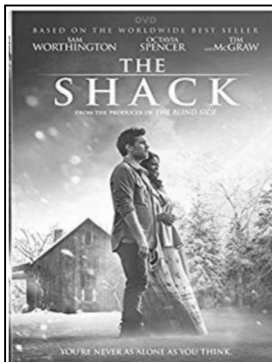

Movie for June

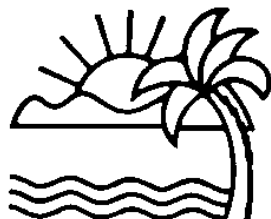
“The Shack” (2017)
