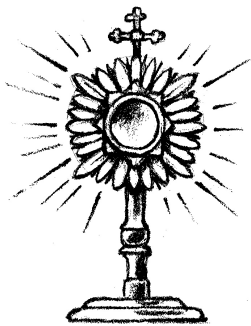

The committee is formed in groups of five or six people who become a part of a team and are called upon when a parish member passes, and the family has requested a luncheon. The more members we have, the less of a burden it is for the committee teams to provide this service.

We ask volunteers to prepare some salads, sandwiches, desserts necessary to complete a light luncheon meal. Some members who prefer not to cook or bake could provide beverages, chips, pickles, or maybe even condiments. There is also a need for volunteers to participate in the serving, the day of the luncheon. We do not ask for more than what you can give.

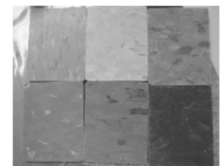
SAINT JOHN XXIII PARISH WISH LIST

The time has come to again reach out to you, our parishioners. We find that we are again in need of your assistance in order to maintain the properties in the parish. We have been making every attempt to manage the upkeep, but it is now out of our reach. The following are the most critical items that need attention.

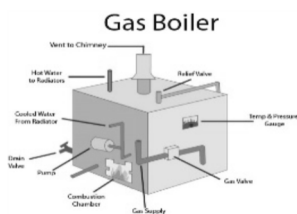


The Tri-State Fire Protection company has notified us that the fire panel is outdated and suggest the need that it be replaced, as it is too old and replacement parts would not be available, \$3,500.00

You may have noticed the “colorful” floor in the church. The broken tiles have been replaced, with non-asbestos tiles. We have investigated the removal of all the asbestos tiles and replacement of the original floor (installed in 1954) to include hazardous waste disposal for the sum of \$40,000.00. We did receive a very generous donation toward the replacement, but not nearly enough to cover the full cost.



Replace incandescent/or fluorescent lights in all the structures on both campuses with LED equipment. Estimated costs \$10,000.00. The expense would be negligible considering the savings in the power use costs over time.



The age of the boilers in Nashua (convent-rectory-church) are at a point where we will need to consider replacing them at an estimated cost of \$25,000.00 each.

(New boilers have already been replaced in Hudson.)

The Parish Wish List continues to grow...

We needed to replace the hot water tank in the church on the Hudson campus. The cost was \$1,530.00 for a 50 gallon tank.

Would there be anyone in the parish who might consider stepping forward to help cover this expense, or making a pledge toward helping us to fulfill the wish list??
