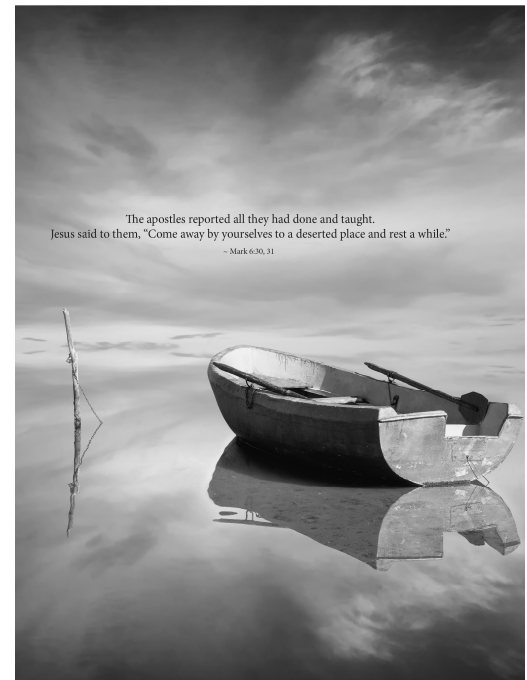

CORPUS CHRISTI PANTRY NEWS

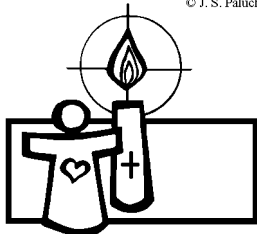
