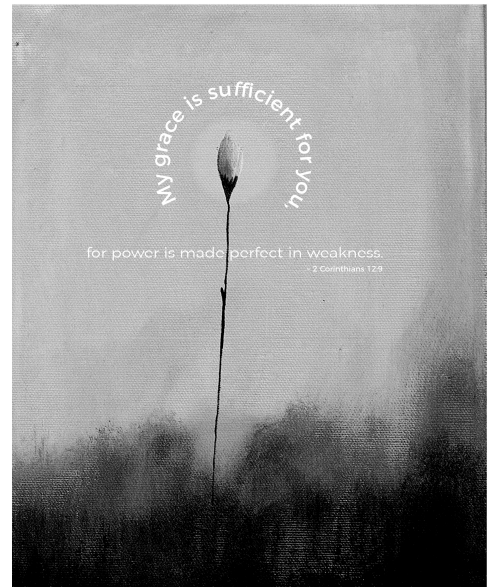

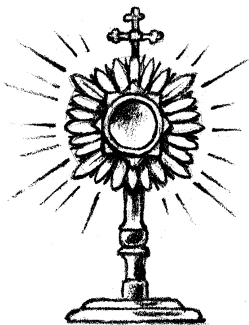

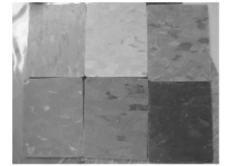
INFANT JESUS SCHOOL **A Catholic elementary school serving grades PreK through Sixth.**

SAINT JOHN XXIII PARISH WISH LIST UPDATE

We find that we are again in need of your assistance in order to maintain the properties in the parish. We have been making every attempt to manage the upkeep, but it is now out of our reach. The following are the most critical items that need attention:

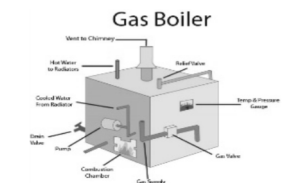
You may have noticed the “colorful” floor in the church. The broken tiles have been replaced, with non-asbestos tiles. We have investigated the removal of all the asbestos tiles and replacement of the original floor (installed in 1954) to include hazardous waste disposal for the sum of \$40,000. We did receive a very generous donation toward the replacement, but not nearly enough to cover the full cost.



Replace incandescent/or fluorescent lights in all the structures on both campuses with LED equipment. Estimated costs \$10,000. The expense would be negligible considering the savings in the power use costs over time.



The age of the boilers in Nashua (convent-rectory-church) are at a point where we will need to consider replacing them at an estimated cost of \$25,000 each. (New boilers have already been replaced in Hudson.)



It is with great pleasure for us to report that we received another anonymous and very generous donation to fulfill some of the “Wish List”.

We received sufficient funds to take care of the replacement of the fire panel for the church in Nashua and for the hot water heater in the church in Hudson, with the balance applied to reducing what will be needed to complete the floor replacement in the church hall in Nashua.



~~The Tri-State Fire Protection~~ company has notified us that the fire panel is outdated and suggest the need that it be replaced, as it is too old and replacement parts would not be available, \$3,500.



~~June 2018...We needed to replace~~ the hot water tank in the church on the Hudson campus. The cost was \$1,530 for a 50 gallon tank.

As we continue to move forward, we thank God for the generosity of these people and express our deepest and most sincere appreciaton for their support of the parish.
