The project we are currently focusing on is the removal and replacement of the church hall floor. To date, we have a total of **\$26,130.74** (\$18,130.74 + \$8,000) which is earmarked for this project. We need roughly \$45,000+/- to complete this project. Estimates are still coming in.

# Parish Wish List

- **FIRE PANEL, STROBE LIGHTS, EXTERIOR BEACON & REMOTE ANNUNCIATOR**

We were advised that replacing the fire panel requires additional items to be added to bring us within code of the Fire Department. It will be necessary to add strobe lights in the rest rooms (3), an exterior beacon and remote annunciator at the main entrance. The cost was \$3,743.25 to complete the project.

*UPDATE: Project paid for and the installation completed.*

- **HOT WATER HEATER**

June 2018... We needed to replace the hot water tank in the church on the Hudson campus. The cost was \$1,530 for a 50 gallon tank.

*UPDATE: Project paid for and the new hot water heater installed.*

- **YOU MAY HAVE NOTICED** the “colorful” floor in the church hall. The broken tiles have been replaced, with non-asbestos tiles. We have investigated the removal of all the asbestos tiles and replacement of the original floor (installed in 1954), to include hazardous waste disposal, for roughly \$45,000. Estimates are still coming in.

*UPDATE: Church hall closed until project can be completed.*

- **THE AGE OF THE BOILERS** in Nashua (convent-rectory-~~church~~) are at a point where we will need to consider replacing them at an estimated cost of \$25,000 each. (New boilers have already been replaced in Hudson.)

*UPDATE: The church boiler has been paid for. We hope to have the new boiler installed before the heating season starts.*

- **REPLACE INCANDESCENT/OR FLUORESCENT LIGHTS** in all the structures on both campuses with LED equipment. Estimated costs \$10,000. The expense would be negligible considering the savings in the power use costs over time.

*UPDATE: This is not a priority at this time; but we are leaving this project in for informational purposes.*
