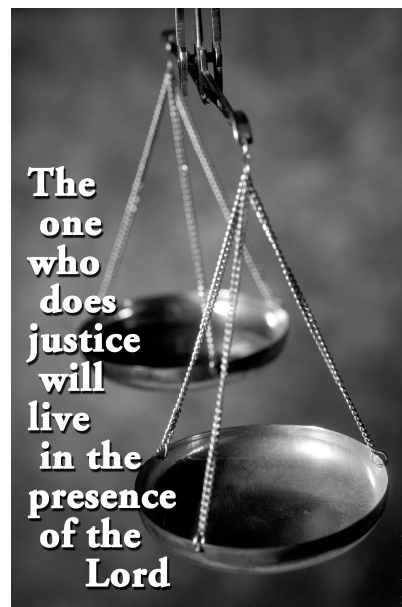

## FAMILY ROSARY BASKET AVAILABLE

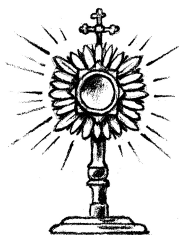
