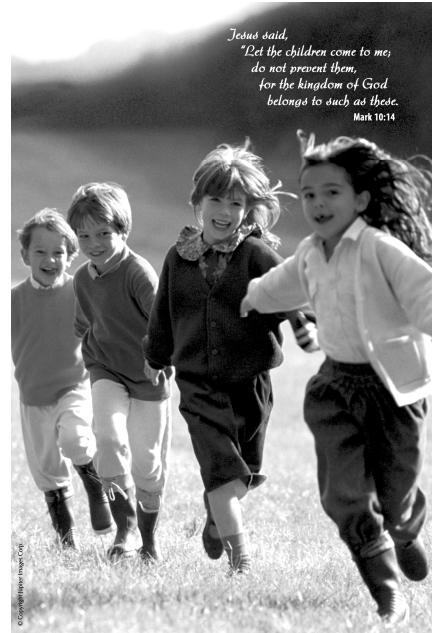

FINANCE COMMITTEE UPDATE

The Parish Finance Committee has been meeting on an ongoing basis to address "Wish List" items and their progress.

We have received approval from the Diocese for work to be done on the church hall floor. The next step is for the contractor to file the necessary state permits, and the abatement process can begin. After the tiles and mastic are removed, the floor will be painted with a 2-part epoxy paint. A painted floor will be easier to maintain and the cost will be thousands less than a tiled floor. We will continue to provide updates for your information.

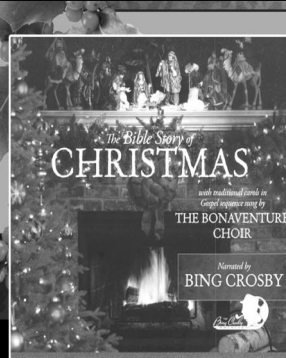
