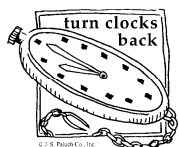


INFANT JESUS SCHOOL HONORING OUR VETERANS AND ACTIVE MILITARY

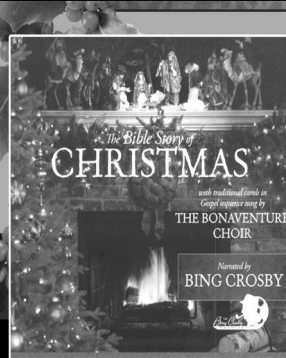
