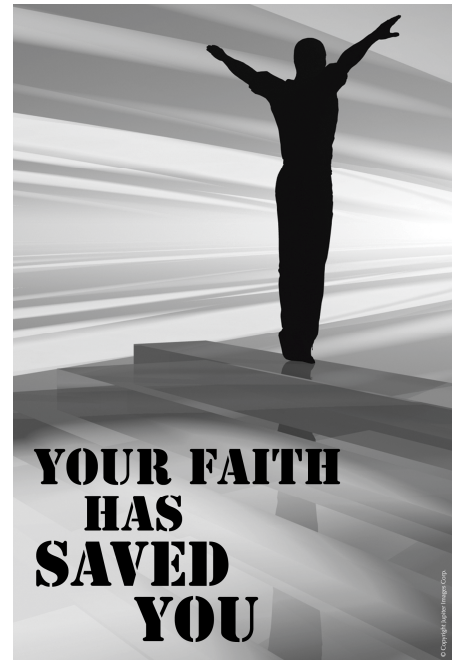

## **Wish List Update**

- **FIRE PANEL, STROBE LIGHTS, EXTERIOR BEACON & REMOTE ANNUNCIATOR**

Replacing the fire panel required additional items to be added to bring us within code. It was necessary to add strobe lights in the restrooms (3), an exterior beacon and remote annunciator at the main entrance.

**COST: \$5,329.50**

**Completed**

- **HOT WATER HEATER**

June 2018...We needed to replace the hot water tank in the church on the Hudson campus.

**COST: \$1,530.00**

**Completed**

- **NASHUA CHURCH HALL FLOOR ABATEMENT**

We have a signed contract for the removal of all the asbestos tiles (installed in 1954), which includes hazardous waste disposal, for **\$25,700**. We were fortunate to receive \$17,000 from the Diocesan Emergency Fund. After the tiles and mastic are removed, the floor will be painted with a 2-part epoxy paint. A painted floor will be easier to maintain and the cost will be thousands less than a tiled floor. Through the generosity of parishioner, Miro Vieira and Vieira Painting, our cost for this part of the project should be **\$1,000 or less**.

**COST: \$26,700.00**

**In Progress**

- **BOILER REPLACEMENT (NASHUA CHURCH)**

Dedicated donations received toward the church boiler are \$26,000. Estimates still coming in are higher than expected, between \$55,000 and \$70,000.

**COST: between \$55, 000 & \$70,000**

**In Progress**

- **BOILER REPLACEMENT (NASHUA RECTORY & CONVENT)**

Due to the age of these two boilers, they will need to be replaced at a later date. We anticipate roughly \$50,000 per boiler.

**COST: \$100,000**

**Funds Needed**

- **NASHUA CHURCH SOUND SYSTEM**

Monies were not taken from the "Wish List" funds. Donations toward the sound system would be appreciated.

**COST: \$4,272.25**

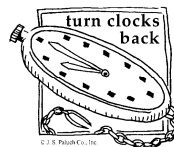
### ALL SOULS DAY ENVELOPES

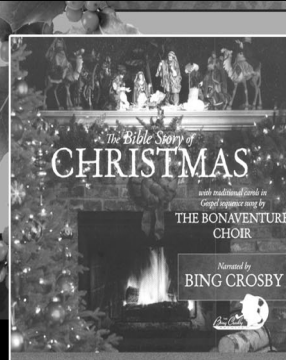
