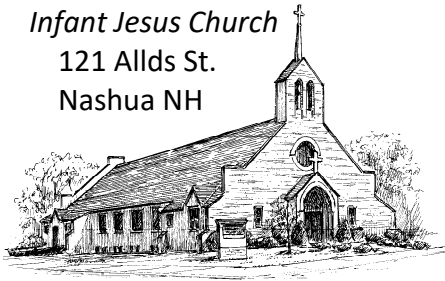
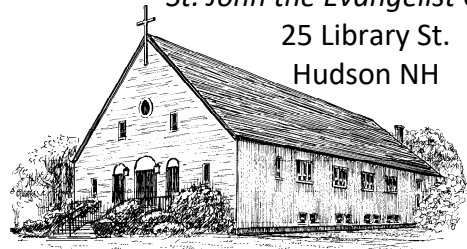

Introducing Our New Priests:

David Wong, born in Port-of-Spain, Trinidad and Tobago, is the son of Mrs. Lim Wong and the late Mr. Everard Wong. He grew up in Trinidad and attended Fatima College. In 1985 he came to the U. S. to study at the Univ. of Pennsylvania and eventually earned a JD degree from Suffolk Univ. Law School, in Boston. He practiced law in Massachusetts and is a parishioner of St. Patrick Parish, Nashua. He attended St. John's Seminary in Brighton, MA.

Adrian Frackowiak is a native of Gniezno Poland and is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Artur and Małgorzata Frackowiak. Adrian came to the U. S. in 2015 to pursue studies to the priesthood at Sts. Cyril & Methodius Seminary in Orchard Lake, Michigan. Previously in Poland, he attended secondary school at Zjazdu Gnieźnieńskiego School and seminary at Prymasowskie Wyższe Seminarium Duchowne.
