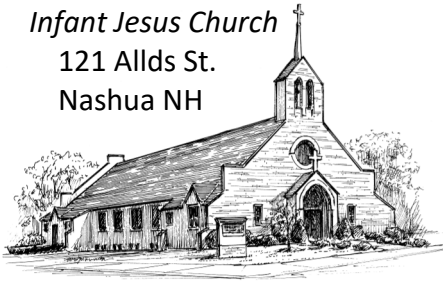
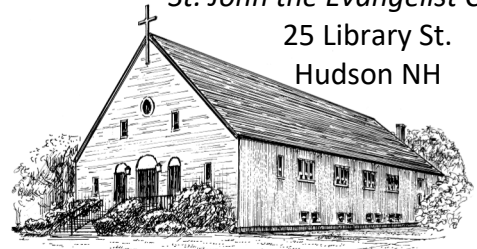

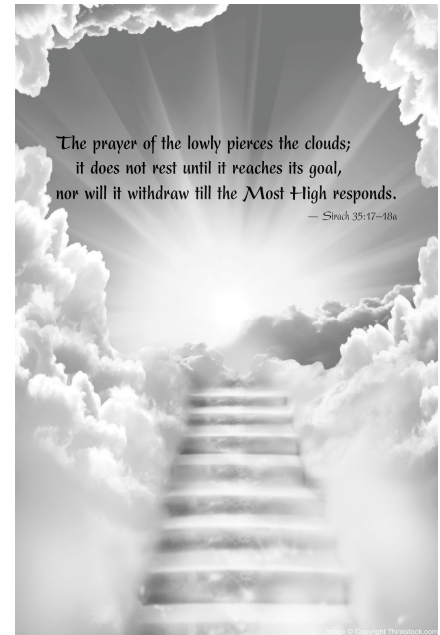

ARCHDIOCESE FOR MILITARY SERVICES

Established by St. John Paul II in 1985, the AMS is the only U.S. Diocese responsible for providing pastoral care to men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces. The archdiocese serves approximately 1.8 million Catholics. While the salaries and retirement of Catholic military chaplains are paid for by the U.S. Government, the AMS receives no funding from the government, or military, for program and administrative costs.
