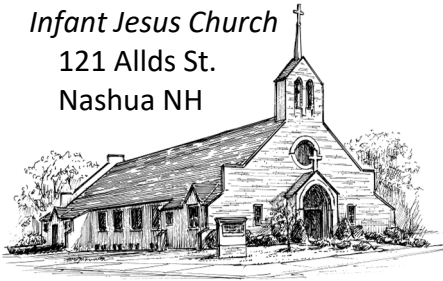
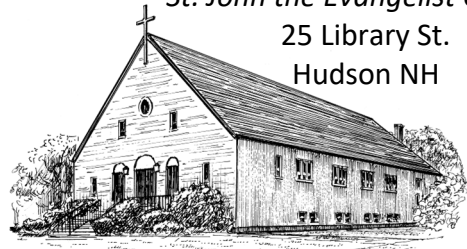

## SAFEGUARDS IN PLACE FOR OUR PUBLIC CELEBRATION OF MASS:

- Everyone is asked to follow **social distancing** protocol at all times.

- Music is to be kept to one musician and one cantor. **Congregational singing is discouraged/not** allowed to reduce the risk of spreading the virus.
