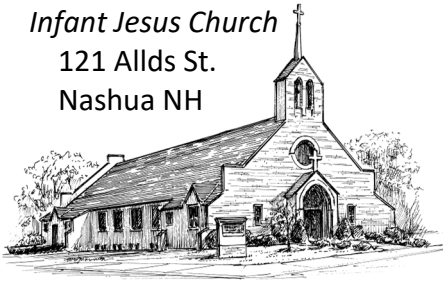
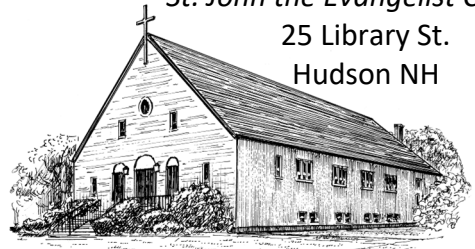

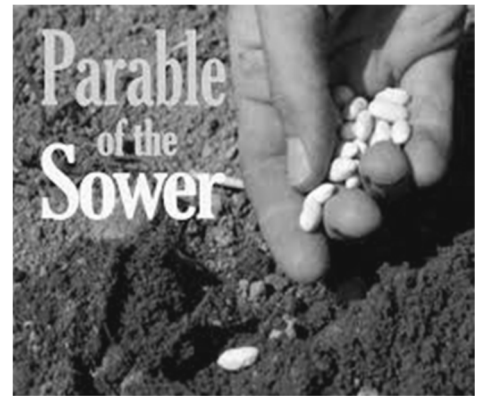

SAFEGUARDS IN PLACE FOR OUR PUBLIC CELEBRATION OF MASS:

- Everyone is asked to follow **social distancing** protocol at all times.
