INFANT JESUS SCHOOL

NEW HOME OF FAMILY PROMISE

In April of 2020, our parish entered into a twenty year lease with Family Promise of Southern New Hampshire to repurpose the Infant Jesus School building. This is a wonderful opportunity for both the parish and the families in need of assistance. Construction is well underway and progressing nicely. In the end there will be space for 24 families. We will publish updates on the progress as things unfold. The current goal is the secure occupancy for the basement and first floor by January 1, 2021, with the completion of the second floor by February 25, 2021.

At Family Promise of Southern New Hampshire, families find a "Home for now" while learning how to become and stay independent. Families accepted into the program learn how to get back on their feet financially and emotionally, and secure stable housing for the long-term. Family Promise accepts all families, no matter how they identify themselves as a family. Families are referred to their program and, once accepted, become residents. Families receive case management addressing parenting and family advocacy, finances, and career development. The goal is for families to graduate within a year to begin their independent lives.

CATHOLIC CHARITIES NH TO HOST ONLINE BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT GROUP

Catholic Charities NH is hosting a new online innovative support group for parishioners across the Diocese who are dealing with grief and loss. "Bereavement – Experiencing Loss, Being Lost and Finding your Way Again" is a (free) six-session program allowing participants to learn about the dynamics of grief, discover new ways to cope while healing and gain the opportunity to be supported and support others also sharing a painful journey.
